SPECTATOR GUIDE

Do you have a loved one, friend or family member who is racing the Hangar Half Marathon? Then you need to know how to catch as much of the action as possible. Look through this Guide to find out how you can maximize your spectating at the event.

The Half Marathon will start at The District at Tustin Legacy, an open-air entertainment and shopping center. Runners will proceed through one of the two Tustin blimp hangars, among the largest wooden structures ever built and rarely open to the public. These impressive structures are seventeen stories high, over 1,000 feet long and 300 feet wide! Then on to the Marketplace, another fantastic open-air shopping and entertainment center; and then to historic Old Town Tustin, with its tree-lined streets and historic buildings dating back to the 1880's. The Half Marathon then returns to the District for the finish line celebration.

RACE SCHEDULE:

- 5:30 am Registration and Packet Pickup opens
- 7:00 am Half Marathon Starts
- 7:30 am 5K Run/Walk Starts

No spectators will be allowed inside the Hangar property, so once your participant leaves the start line there are a couple of vantage points along the course that are easy to access with your car.



OLD TOWN TUSTIN

(A perfect viewing location with food, crafts and live music)

Leave either the District Shopping Center or the Marketplace Shopping Center

- Head north on Jamboree Road.
- Turn left on Irvine Blvd
- Turn left on Newport
- Turn right on First Street
- Turn Left on Centennial Way

Park at Tustin City Hall or Tustin Public Library and you can see the course at the end of the street (Centennial Way and Main Street) From Main Street you can walk towards Old Town Tustin to El Camino Real (2 blocks) and then north on El Camino Real to 3rd Street and find the Street fair with booths, crafts and live music by the School of Rock. Runners pass this general area 4Xs as they move through Old Town Tustin.

THE MARKETPLACE AT EL CAMINO REAL AND JAMBOREE ROAD

(A quick trip to see your participant)

Leave the District Shopping Center and head North on Jamboree Road. After you cross under the 5 Freeway, make a left onto El Camino Real. You can park to right and walk through the Market Place to West Drive, where the School of Rock will be playing at the turn-around in front of CPK Restaurant. Or you can park near Home Depot and Miguel's Restaurant and see the route as it passes El Camino Real and West Drive 2Xs.
